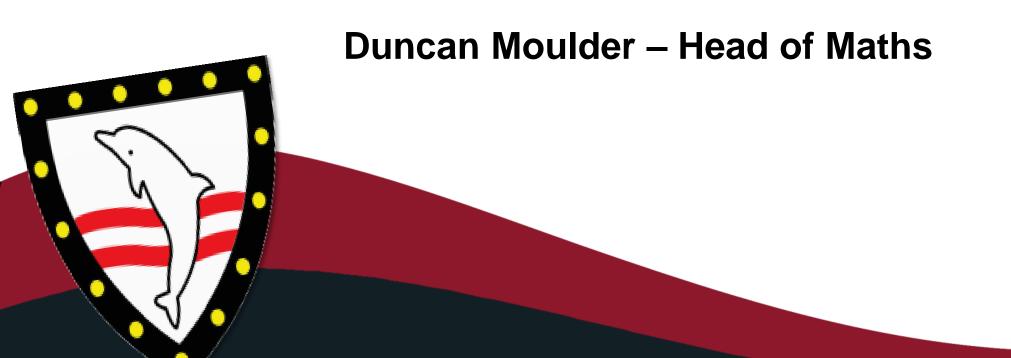
## Revising GCSE Maths
