- Do the extras (XP Boost, Target)
- Sparx independent learning
- Ultimate Practice Paper Revision



## Conversation with student...

Student: Sir, I did loads of past paper revision over the weekend

Teacher: Great! What sort of scores were you getting?

Student: I have no idea, The mark scheme I found online was really difficult to understand.
